QuickBooks Tip:

Control Y – When these keys are pressed on any Form in QuickBooks – ie: Sales Invoice, AP Bill, Check, etc., QuickBooks will show you the back-end Journal Entry, in debits and credits. This is very cool because some people still think that QB is not a double-entry accounting system, and this puts that to rest once and for all. It also helps an accountant (or user for that matter) to figure out what the effect of their entry is on the GL. Sometimes T-Accounts just don't cut it.!
